## Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) 252.204-7012

## Dear Government Contractors,

Are you ready for Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) 252.204-7012? DFARS 252.204-7012 requires <u>all</u> Department of Defense (DoD) contractors and subcontractors of those DoD contractors to provide adequate security on all Covered Defense Information (CDI) that resides on the contractor's or subcontractor's information systems by implementing security measures laid out by the National Institute





of Standards and Technology (NIST) Special Publication (SP) 800-171 "as soon as possible," but <u>no later than 12/31/2017</u>. CDI is any unclassified information that is provided to the contractor by or on behalf of the DoD in connection with the performance of the contract or is collected, developed, received, transmitted, used, or stored by or on behalf of the contractor in support of the performance of the contract.
